NOTIFICATION

MAHARASHTRA UNAIDED PRIVATE PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION AND FEES) ACT, 2015.

No. TEM-2016/CR 473(Part 1)/TE-4 .-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 3 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fees) Act, 2015 (Maharashtra Act. No. XXVIII of 2015), and in supersession of Government Notification, Higher and Technical Education Department, No. TEM-2015/CR 536/TE-4 dated 11th March 2016, the Government of Maharashtra hereby, notifies the Full Time Professional Courses mentioned in column (2) of the **Schedule A for Diploma Courses, Schedule B for Undergraduate Degree Courses** and **Schedule C for Post Graduate Degree Courses**, as the case may be, of the Schedule appended hereto, for the purpose of Admission to the said Courses.

(3) NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries, Foreign National.-

(i) The candidate should have passed the HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects, and obtained at least 50 % marks in the above subjects taken together;

(ii) Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time.

(B) Direct Second Year (Lateral Entry) Admission, -For Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate and All India Candidature Candidate,—

(i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;

(ii) Passed Diploma Course in Engineering and Technology with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) in appropriate branch of Engineering and Technology from an All India Council for Technical Education or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent;

Or

(ii) Passed B.Sc. Degree from a University Grants Commission (UGC) or Association of Indian Universities recognized University with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) and passed HSC with Mathematics as a subject:

Provided that students belonging to this category shall clear the subjects of Engineering Graphics/ Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the first year Engineering Program along with second year subjects.

(iii) Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time.

2 Undergraduate Course in Pharmacy (B.Pharm.)

(1) Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates and All India Candidature Candidates.-

(i) The candidate should be an Indian National;

(ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biotechnology or Biology and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together ;

(iii) Obtained Score in CET.

(2) NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries, Foreign National.-

(i) The candidate should have passed the HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biotechnology or Biology, and obtained at least 50 % marks in the above subjects taken together ;

(ii) Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time.

(i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;

(ii) Passed Diploma Course in Pharmacy with at least 45 % marks (at least 40 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) from an All India Council for Technical Education or Pharmacy Council of India or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent.

(iii) Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time.

3 Pharm D.

Maharashtra State Candidature and All India Candidature Candidates,-

(i) The candidate should be an Indian National;

(ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with subjects Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biotechnology or Biology and obtained at least 50 % marks (at least 45 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together ;

Or

(ii) Passed Diploma Course in Pharmacy from institutes affiliated to State Board and having approval of competent central authority and State Government and obtained at least 50 % marks (at least 45 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State);

(iii) The candidate should have obtained at least 50% marks in the CET;

(ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent with Mathematics and obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (at least 45% marks in aggregate in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) or as declared by appropriate authority, from time to time;
