

Report of XIX Pharma Quiz & XII Young Pharmacist Innovative Project Award (YPIPA)

6th February 2020

Saraswathi Vidya Bhavan's College of Pharmacy, Dombivli organized XIX Pharma Quiz & XII Young Pharmacist Innovative Project Award (YPIPA) on 6th February 2020.

The idea of organizing State level Pharma quiz was conceptualised in the year 1999. Since then, the college has been hosting this event every year on a grand scale. Synergistic with this colossal event, is another flagship endeavor of SVBCP i.e. the "YPIPA or Young Pharmacist Innovative Project Award".

The events began with the inaugural function. The ceremonial lamp was lit by the dignitaries: **Chief Guest Prof. Dr. V.S. Velingkar, Technical Director of H.K.College of Pharmacy, Mumbai, Evaluators Mr.MilindJadhav, General Manager Turbhe Chemicals and Mr. Mahesh Abhyankar, Founder and Managing Director Abhyankar Ayurvedics Pvt. Ltd.,** Dr.Monita Gide-In charge Principal SVB's college of Pharmacy, Dr.Chhaya Gadgoli- HOD Pharmacognosy department.

In the inaugural function Dr.Monita Gide, In-charge Principal, warmly welcomed the guests and delegates. In her welcome address, she explained the significance of YPIPA and added that such events nurture young pharmacists to take up innovative research and give a platform to them to present their ideas. She also took the opportunity to congratulate the "GPAT All India Rank - 8" student of SVBCP Mr Deepak Chaudhary. The welcome address was followed by felicitation of the dignitaries. The chief guests addressed the students and stressed on innovation and applicability of research work to industries. He emphasised on the word IDEA which is a pedagogical tool for young research. He instructed the students to think innovative and dedicatedly work to achieve success. This was followed by the inauguration of the YPIPA posters and the elimination round of Pharma quiz. The total participation was **142 students from 15 colleges**. There were **26 teams for YPIPA** and **42 teams for Pharma Quiz**.
